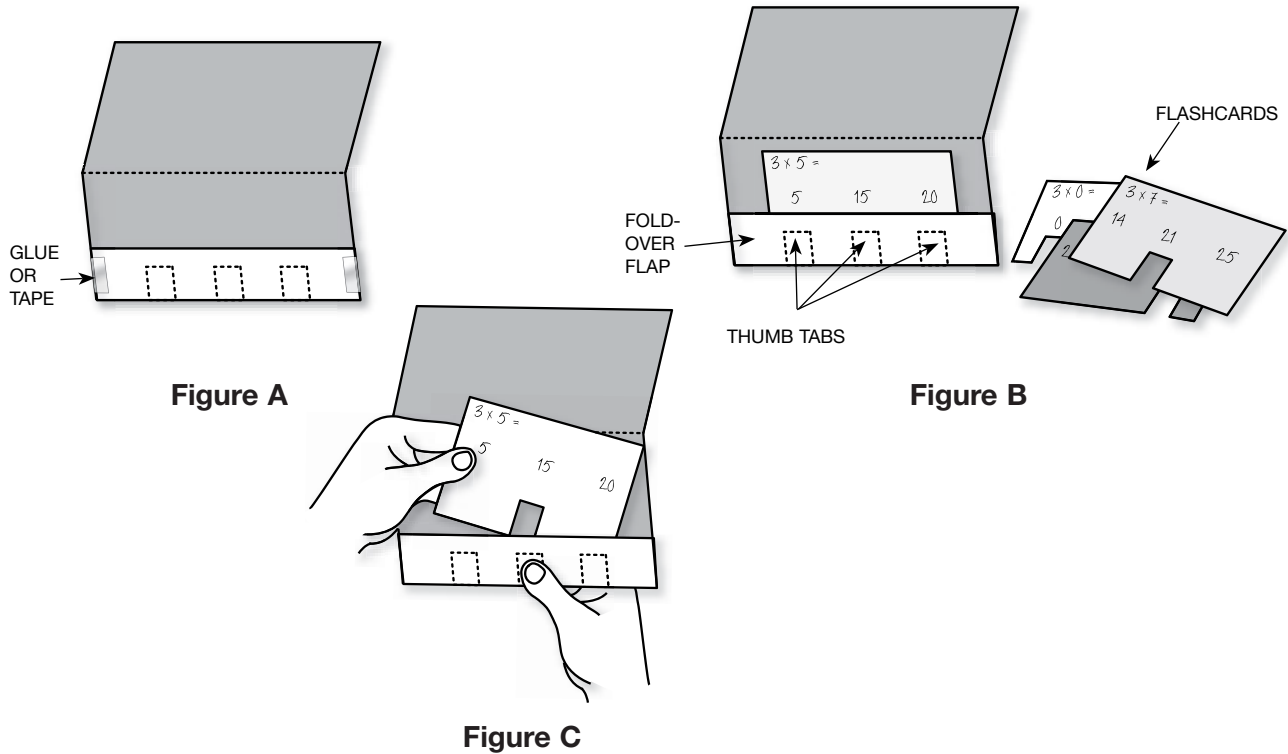


## Flashcards (2 Die Set)



The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut one Flashcard Holder from cardstock or other paper. Fold on perforated lines.
  2. Glue or tape the sides of the perforated fold-over flap (Figure A).
  3. Color each of the three thumb tabs a different color.
  4. Die-cut as many Flashcards as desired. Make different sets to practice different skills...math equations, vowel sounds, state capitals, uppercase and lowercase letters, etc.
  5. Write a question or equation along the top of the Flashcard.
  6. Write the correct answer above the thumb tab, with the cutout and two incorrect answers above the remaining thumb tabs (Figure B).
  7. Position Flashcards in the Holder, making sure all three answers are visible above the flap. When a student's thumb is on the correct answer, the Card pulls free (Figure C). Hold the wrong answer and the Card stays put.
- This is a self-checking Flashcard.
