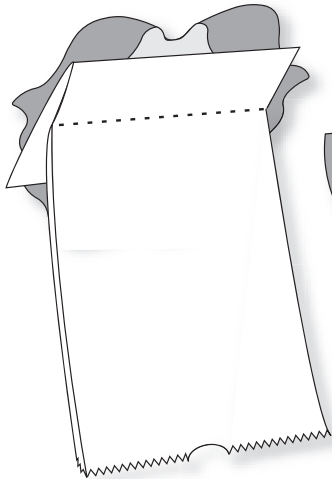


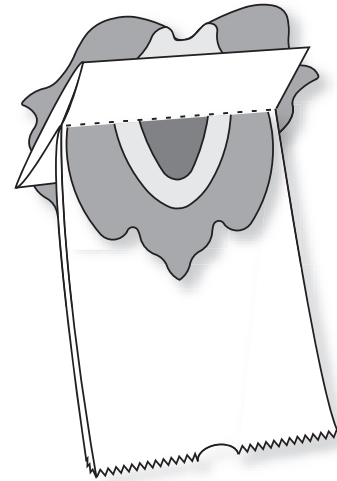
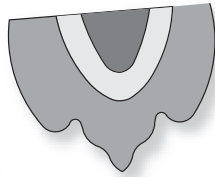
## REQUIREMENTS:

- Machine with 10" or wider opening

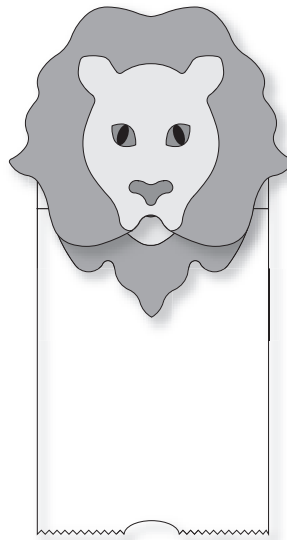
## Paper Bag Puppets

1. Die-cut the XL face and chin of the Puppet from cardstock or other paper. If the Puppet has multiple pieces in the face (the Lion, for example), cut the pieces using various colors.
2. Cut the tongue out of pink or red paper. Tape contrasting pieces of paper behind the eye and nose openings.
3. Glue the face section to the flap portion of a paper bag (Figure A).
4. Lift flap and glue chin and tongue sections under the flap (Figure B).
