

Book Instructions

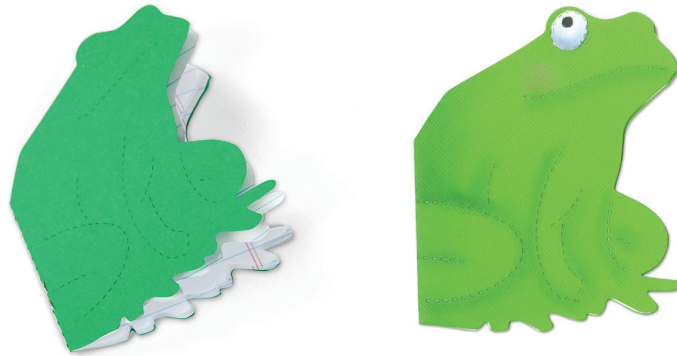

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. To create the front and back cover of the book, place an unfolded piece of cover material over the mirror-image portion of the die and cut according to the instructions provided with your Ellison machine (Figure A).
2. To create the inside pages, place up to 8 layers of folded paper on the single image on the die, with the fold just inside the top and bottom edge of the cutting blade. Cut according to the instructions provided with your Ellison machine (Figure B).
3. Assemble the book by spreading open the inside pages and placing them on top of the cover piece. Apply at least two staples along the center fold of the book as shown (Figure C).
4. Fold the book closed and embellish as desired (Figure D).
